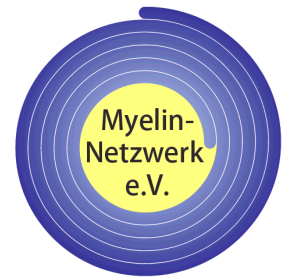

The meeting can be reached from the high-speed/ICE railway station 'Kassel-Wilhelmshöhe' in 15 minutes by bus. Take bus line 51 in the direction of 'Baunatal' or line 52 in the direction of 'Martinshagen'. Leave the bus at the stop 'Brasselsberg', then walk 2 minutes along the same street.

### Surroundings

Next to the hotel is a forest providing opportunities for walking/running. In Kassel-Wilhelmshöhe, there is also the park of Wilhelmshöhe Palace (UNESCO world heritage site; [bad-wilhelmshoehe.de](http://bad-wilhelmshoehe.de)), an art museum with paintings and sculptures and a thermal bath ([kurhessen-therme.de](http://kurhessen-therme.de))
